- SB 1492 directed that we review rules governing the design, construction, operation, maintenance, closure and post-closure monitoring and maintenance of SWMF.
- Stakeholders declined an invitation to a collaborative process
- Stakeholders wanted a draft to sling darts at
- Supervisors reviewing latest draft from Staff- Fall 2010?

WHAT ARE WE THINKING

- Most conventional facilities will not be impacted
 - Will codify what is already in permits by condition
- Back and Forth on Style and content
 - Easy, Hard, Openended, Comprehensive
- A Backbone with room to grow, shingles, C&D, mulch
- Combine all activities as Transfer the noun and the RPS as verb
